Career-Orientation and Counselling Policy

The Career-Orientation and Counselling Policy aims:

- to equip students with the knowledge, skills and support about their future career paths;
- to provide career guidance, counselling, visiting educational fairs, webinars and resources to help students explore their interests, understand career options and develop the necessary skills for successful transitions into further educational and career paths.

Key Components of the Career-Orientation and Counselling Policy include:

- career guidance and counseling via the individual or group sessions;
- access to information about universities, career and educational programs;
- skills development with focus on communication, problem-solving, and critical thinking;
- transition assistance with university applications, resume writing, and interview skills;
- parental involvement related to their children's career exploration, adapting to the student's needs.

Career Counselling targets:

- individual or group sessions with the career counsellors to discuss career goals, educational options and potential career paths;
- career self-assessment tests;
- career-oriented activities, workshops, presentations, and guest speaker events to expose students to different career fields;
- career research platforms to help students research careers, internship and universities options;
- community service or volunteering, work experience programs to gain practical experience;
- university visits to campuses and assistance with university applications.

- personalized support, including for Students of Determination;
- reduced uncertainty with a clear understanding of career-oriented options;
- smooth transitions from school to further education paths.


